Instructions for completing *Understanding bias in health care* modules via LearnOnline

- 1. You can access the Ministry of Health's LearnOnline platform at: <u>https://learnonline.health.nz/</u>.
- 2. Alternatively, the link to the Commission's learning module catalogue is <u>here</u>. Click on *Understanding bias in health care*.
- 3. If you are not registered with LearnOnline you will need to create an account. If you do not receive a registration email or a reset password email, check your email junk/spam folder. Sometimes this issue is at an organisation level and emails may go to your work spam filter. If you are still having issues, please use the 'contact support' link on the LearnOnline homepage.
- 4. For lost or forgotten usernames or passwords, follow the prompts on the LearnOnline login screen.
